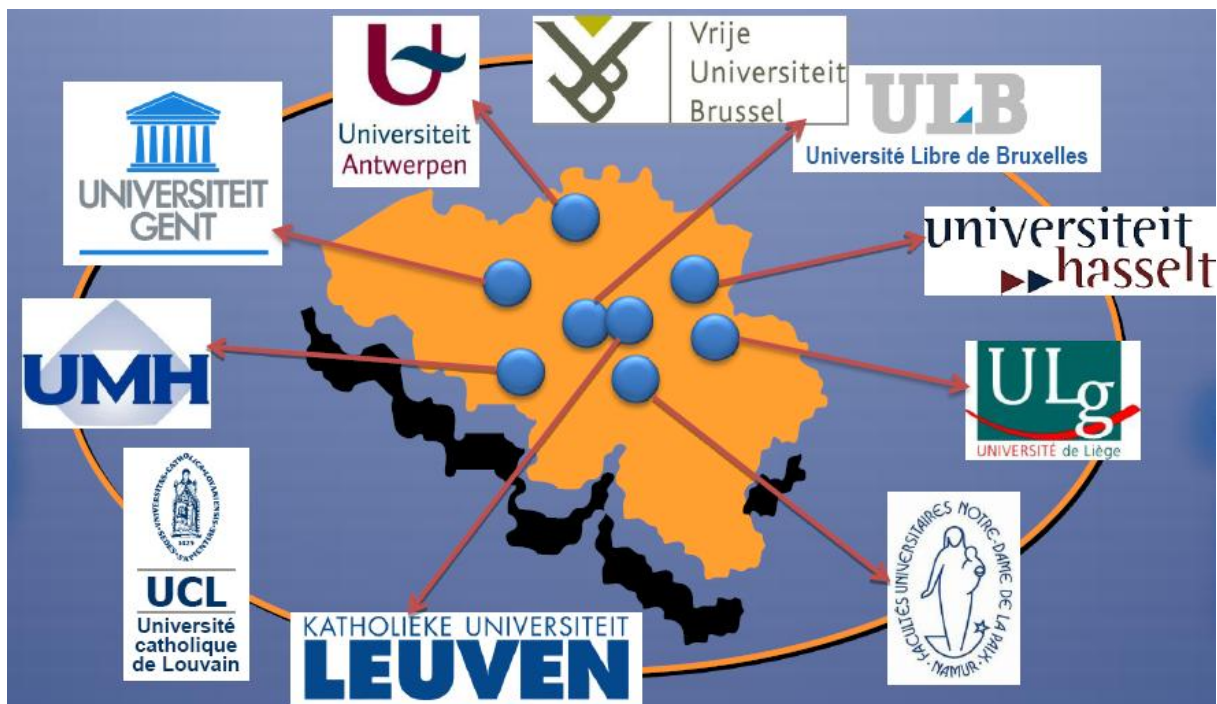


# Interuniversity Master Information Day

## BIOLOGY

This second edition of the National Master Information Day is an event organized by the Royal Belgian Society for Zoology, with the aim to provide a national forum for 3<sup>rd</sup> year bachelor students to inform themselves about the different master programs in Biology currently organised at all Belgian universities.



During this day, all universities that currently have a master program in Biology, and associated master programs, will present their master programs. Students are invited to participate in this master day, which involves oral presentations by the university representatives and subsequently, a get-together with them, when also other master programs will be illustrated.

This master day will take place on **Saturday, March 6<sup>th</sup> 2010**. The place to be is the Royal Belgian Institute for Natural Sciences in Brussels (the 'dino museum'). The address is Vautierstraat 29, 1000 Brussels.
